



Award Judging Criteria –Custom Luminaire 2015

Judging Criteria & Guidelines – 35 Points Possible

If any criterion is not specifically addressed, a minimum of 3 points (per 10 available) will be awarded. If certain topics do not apply, topic should be scored according to how well the designer addressed the topic.

Scoring

Why (10 Points Possible)

- Problems Addressed (3 - 10 Points)
 - Has the intent behind needing a custom luminaire been adequately explained? What issues arose that drove the project to create a custom luminaire instead of an off the shelf product.

Creativity (20 Points Possible)

- Aesthetics (3 – 10 Points)
 - Have the aesthetic choices been explained and qualified? Does the designed luminaire fit within the project space and design? Is the final product accomplishing the designer's goals?
- Technical Value (3 – 10 Points)
 - Have the technical requirements of the luminaire been explained and qualified? Does the final product fulfill those requirements? Is the final product useful and easily maintained?

Exemplary (5 Points Possible)

- Judges can assign up to 5 additional points for custom luminaire designs that exceed expectations.
